Eligibility: Open to all artist. All work must be original.

Requirements: Works may not exceed 24" in any dimension, including frame or bases. All works must be ready for display, 2 dimensions work must be suitably framed and wired for hanging. 3 dimensions work maybe required to supply pedestals where necessary. Print the following information in notification card at Kumono Gallery: artist's name, title of work, year, medium and price.

As reception performance entries, ask Kumono Gallery in person by phone. performance may not exceed 5 minutes.

Fees: Entry is free, with maximum of TWO entries per artist. Administrative fee will be charged \$30 per artist is accepted.

Sales: Kumono Gallery takes no commission on sales from this exhibition.

Hand delivered entries: Aug. 21st, from 5 to 8 p.m. and 22nd, from 1 to 6 p.m. All packing materials, crates, wrapping, etc will be removed from the premises by the artist or his/her agent, when possible.

Return of entries: Aug. 28th, from 5 to 8 p.m. and 29th, from 1 to 6 p.m. A result of accepted artists will be posted at Kumono Gallery. After these 2 days, if not posted artist do not pick up his/her works, the Gallery will not have any responsibility for them.

Reception: Sep. 5th, 6 to 9 p.m.

Removal work: Sep. 12th, from 6 to 8 p.m. and 13th, from 1 to 6 p.m. After these 2 days, the Gallery will not have any responsibility for them.
